WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of applying for a TIGER Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the purpose of completing improvements to 271st Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council commits to provide local match for the TIGER Grant equal to at least the utility (water and sewer) portion of the project, which is estimated at \$1,124,506.



TIGER GRANT APPLICATION SPONSORSHIP

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Commission and the City of Tea have determined the need for the 271st Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, funding assistance is necessary to enable construction of these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission is in support of the City of Tea applying for a TIGER Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the purpose of completing improvements to 271st Street; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission commits to contribute to the local match for the TIGER Grant in the amount of \$250,000 for the engineering portion of the project in calendar year 2016.

WHEREAS, the County Commission commits to contribute to the local match for the TIGER Grant in an amount to be negotiated as part of transfer jurisdictional agreement for the reconstruction portion of the project in calendar year 2018.

BE IT RESOLVED the City Council hereby authorizes the filing of an application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, for the TIGER Grant Program, and hereby designates the Mayor to act as signatory in connection with the application and other required forms, and to provide such additional information as may be required by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
