The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) is an important component of transportation planning for the Sioux Falls Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). Working with the Citizens Advisory Committee and the Urbanized Development Commission (governing body for the MPO), members of the TAC serve as technical staff for the formal transportation planning process. In addition, the TAC conducts official public hearings on all of the federally required products of the MPO planning process. The TAC meets seven times a year (every other month beginning in January) with an additional meeting held in August. Meetings are held at the SECOG Center in Sioux Falls on Thursday afternoons and begin at 2:00 p.m.

Representatives will be selected by several criteria including the ability to review planning products and plans while considering technical aspects of transportation planning products such as costs, construction phasing, engineering design and associated issues.
