

**SIOUX FALLS METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
RESOLUTION #2022-02**

ENDORSEMENT OF TRANSIT SAFETY AND PERFORMANCE MEASURE TARGETS ESTABLISHED BY SDDOT.

WHEREAS, the Urbanized Development Commission (UDC) of the South Eastern Council of Governments has been designated by the Governor of the State of South Dakota as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Sioux Falls Metropolitan Planning Area;

WHEREAS the Transit Safety Plan final rule (49 CFR Part 670) requires States to set targets for transit safety and performance measures;

WHEREAS, the South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) has established the following the transit safety and performance measure targets:

- Fatalities: One fatality per total revenue miles,
- Injuries: Fifty injuries per total revenue miles,
- Safety Events: Seventy-five events per total revenue miles,
- System Reliability: One failure per 15,000 total revenue miles,
- Rolling Stock: 72% or more of revenue vehicles in a State of Good Repair (SGR), and
- Facilities: 95% of facilities rated 3.0 or better on the Transit Economic Requirements Model (TERM) scale.

WHEREAS, the SDDOT coordinated the establishment of transit safety and performance measure targets with the Sioux Falls Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHERE AS, the SDDOT has officially adopted the transit safety and performance measure targets in the South Dakota Public Transportation Safety Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. That the MPO has agreed to support SDDOT's established targets for the transit safety and performance measures.
2. That the MPO will plan and program projects that contribute to the accomplishment of said transit safety and performance measure targets.
