## PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Lincoln County Highway 106 (271st Street) is the future growth boundary between the City of Sioux Falls and City of Harrisburg and currently under the jurisdiction of Lincoln County. The corridor is going to see significant change over the next 20 years, from the opening of Veterans Parkway to future development as Sioux Falls grows southward and Harrisburg grows to the north. This study is a partnership between the South Eastern Council of Governments (SECOG), Lincoln County, City of Harrisburg, City of Sioux Falls, and South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) to develop a long-range plan for the corridor that reflects the future vision for multimodal travel throughout the area.

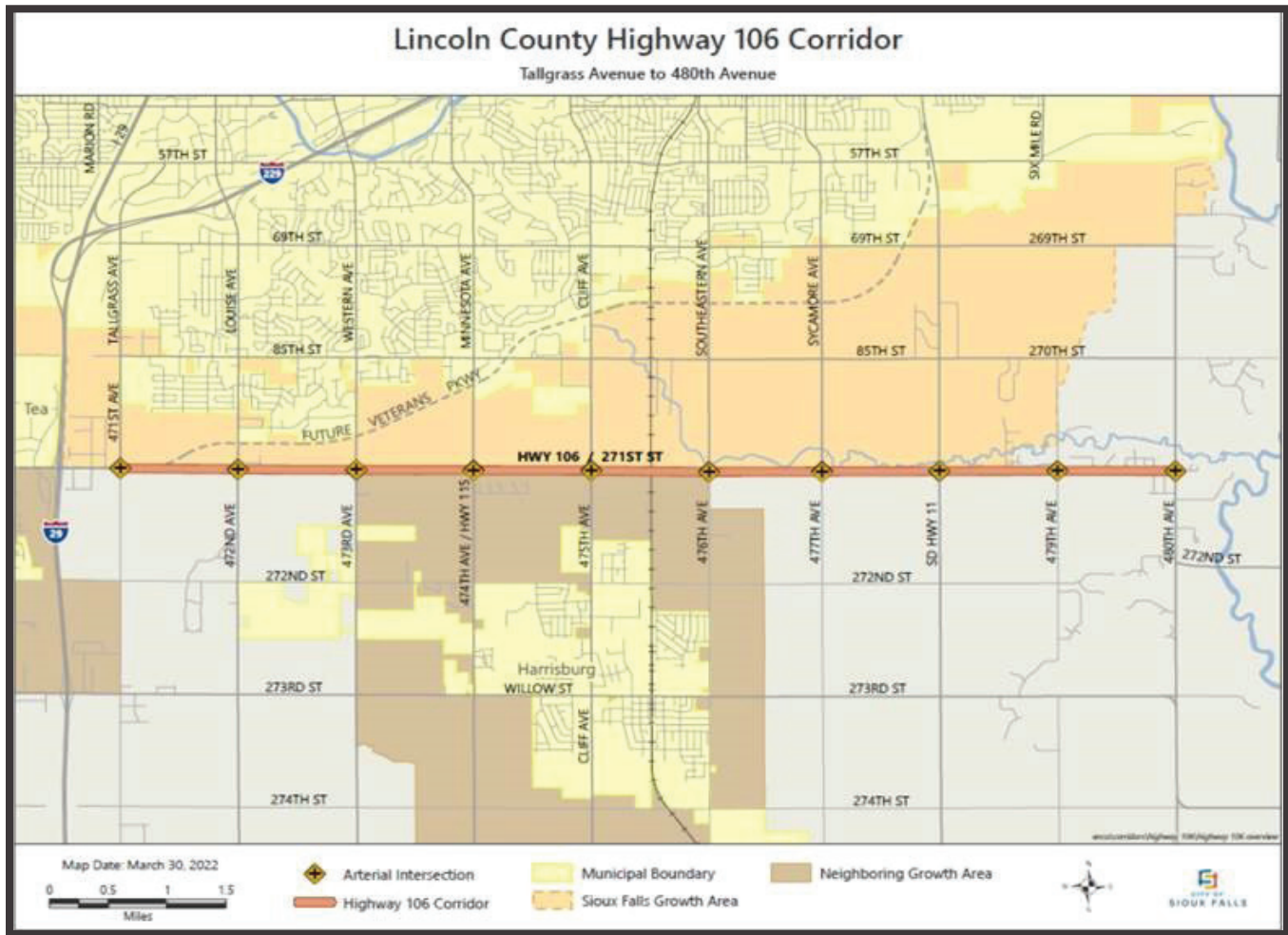

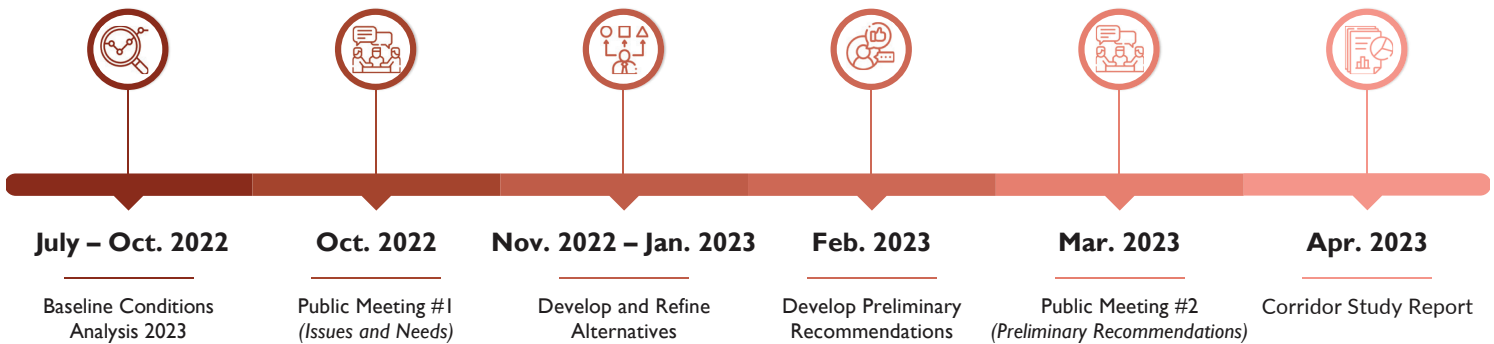
## STUDY GOALS
